

Duet Fingering

Typically, one person plays the Lower Part once through on its own, then the second person begins the Upper Part the second play through.


Lower Part



The LH is in 5-finger position and can be played *without looking* so you can focus on your RH movements.

The RH is also in 5-finger position so you can watch only t and let m and l fall into place.

Upper Part



Pivot on *t* and crossover with *m* to either end the song or restart it from the beginning.
